This service is intended for those unable to come to the library due to disability or illness, or because they are caring for a family member. We serve senior communities, nursing homes, community living facilities, and the homebound.

TBBS provides audio and braille library service via mail or digital download to any Illinois resident who is unable to read standard print material due to a permanent or temporary visual or physical disability.
